Criteria for Ending AIS

Academic Intervention Services will end when the student has successfully attained the district standards according to the State and/or district criteria for discontinuing services.

Recordkeeping

The building principal and/or his/her designee(s) will ensure that the following information is maintained as part of the student's cumulative record folder:

- Record of the student's performance on state and/or local assessments used to determine the student's placement into AIS
- Listing of the specific Academic Intervention Services provided and the dates the student received services
- Copy of all parent notification(s), including initiation and termination of services
- Record of parent/teacher conference
