The room shall be used for the child's educational program, as part of the child's individualized education program, in order to provide the child with an equal opportunity to participate in the general education program of the district.

The School Psychology and/or Behavior Consultant will inform the parent prior to the implementation of the individualized education program that will incorporate the use of a room for the child's educational program.

Upon request, the parent will be notified of the space that will be utilized. In addition, the parent will be provided a copy of this policy.

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Staff will now, in physical, review and identify the student's behavior intervention and modification inappropriate behavior. Staff will not be called upon for physical review and identify the student's behavior intervention and modification.
